Safety Corner – Hot Topics for Host Safety

Injury and Illness Prevention Programs (IIPP)

- Injury prevention happens when a structured, written plan is in place to recognize hazards, how to correct those hazards, and train and track a team's successes
- Employers in California are required to have an IIPP that is accessible by all employees
- Safety shifts from being reactive to being proactive
- Utilizing a plan guarantees incidents are treated as opportunities to learn ("fact-finding, not fault-finding") – the blame game becomes obsolete
- Utilizing programs to recognize and reduce hazards is easily transferred to personal space as well!
