Wildfire Info and Emergency Kits

Mono County, California uses the CodeRed Emergency Alert System (also referred to as the ReadyMono system) to send critical, time-sensitive notifications during emergencies. This system is part of the ReadyMono Emergency Alert System is designed to keep residents and businesses informed during events such as evacuations, hazardous weather alerts, missing persons, active shooter warnings, fire advisories, hazardous materials spills, and public health advisories.

How It Works: Residents and businesses enter their contact information (phone numbers, text, email) into the system. This information is added to a nationwide emergency alert database and remains private, used only for community emergency communications

- **Notifications can include:** Evacuation orders
- Hazardous weather alerts
- Missing persons
- Fire and hazardous materials advisories
- Public health advisories (e.g., boil water notices, viral outbreaks)

Delivery Methods: Alerts are sent via phone, text, and email. The CodeRed Mobile App is geo-aware and will push notifications to subscribers within the alert's coverage area, along with a voice file for up to 24 hours
